

To all residents in the parish of Leek Wootton and Guys Cliffe:

STREET CHAMPIONS

We are living in a dynamic and fast moving crisis where it seems ideas and plans laid out yesterday are already out of date today and we need to recognise these extraordinary circumstances are **not a time for normality**. Our parish has a significant number of elderly and vulnerable residents, many of whom are self isolating already. Many will be fearful and anxious.

STREET CHAMPIONS are the most immediate and efficient way of coordinating care for our community at grass roots level. A street champion is a coordinator/point of contact for a group of residents in the same street. Residents in the group will then be able to contact them **FIRST** for example to:

- Speak about any problems/difficulties they may have
- Arrange for shopping to be done
- Arrange pharmacy pick-ups

The Street Champion will then be the focus for action within that particular group.

HOW TO SET UP YOUR OWN STREET CHAMPIONS?

Please recognise that **SELF HELP** is the order of the day. Below is a suggested list of numbers of Champions needed for all the roads in our community. Individuals need to take action in their neighbourhood now so **GET TOGETHER WITH YOUR NEIGHBOURS PLEASE** in whatever way you can and **nominate your Champion**. Groups should not be too big – maybe 12 houses maximum?
